




Cambridgeshire LLFA welcomes the consideration of using flood risk management measures to promote biodiversity in the Caldecote Village Design Guide SPD.

The Village Design Guide SPD should strive to further promote sustainable drainage techniques (SuDS). SuDS are an approach to managing surface water run-off which seeks to mimic natural drainage systems and retain water on or near the site as opposed to traditional drainage approaches which involve piping water off site as quickly as possible. SuDS offer significant advantages over conventional piped drainage systems in reducing flood risk by attenuating the rate and quantity of surface water run-off from a site, promoting groundwater recharge, and improving water quality and amenity.

The variety of SUDS techniques available means that virtually any development should be able to include a scheme based around these principles.
